additional explanatory description of the reason for such item(s) and possible alternatives/ additions.

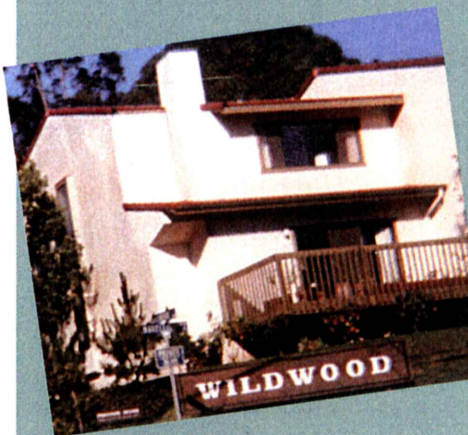
- Basic first aid kit contents checklist (30 items).
